APPLICATION FOR "PERMIT LABEL" RELATIVE TO THE INSTALLATION OF LOW VOLTAGE ALARM SYSTEMS

Pursuant to Florida State Statute 489.503, with provisions effective on October 1, 2013, the undersigned licensed contractor intends to purchase one or more low voltage alarm "permit labels" to be used for the installation or replacement of a new or existing alarm system, with the following conditions:

- The "permit label" is valid for a period of one year from the date of issuance.
- A "permit label" is required for every separate and detached building on a construction site where a low voltage alarm system may be installed or replaced.
- The contractor is required to post the "permit label" in a conspicuous place on the premises before commencing work.
- The contractor is required to notify **The City of Newberry Building Department** within 14 days of completion of an alarm project by submitting a "Uniform Notice of a Low-Voltage Alarm System Project".
- Expired and/ or unused "permit label" fees are not refundable.
- The installation may not include a fire alarm system, or any component(s) thereof.

The City of Newberry Building Department requires all Contractors to provide a License Number, Liability Insurance, and Worker's Compensation Policy at time of application.
